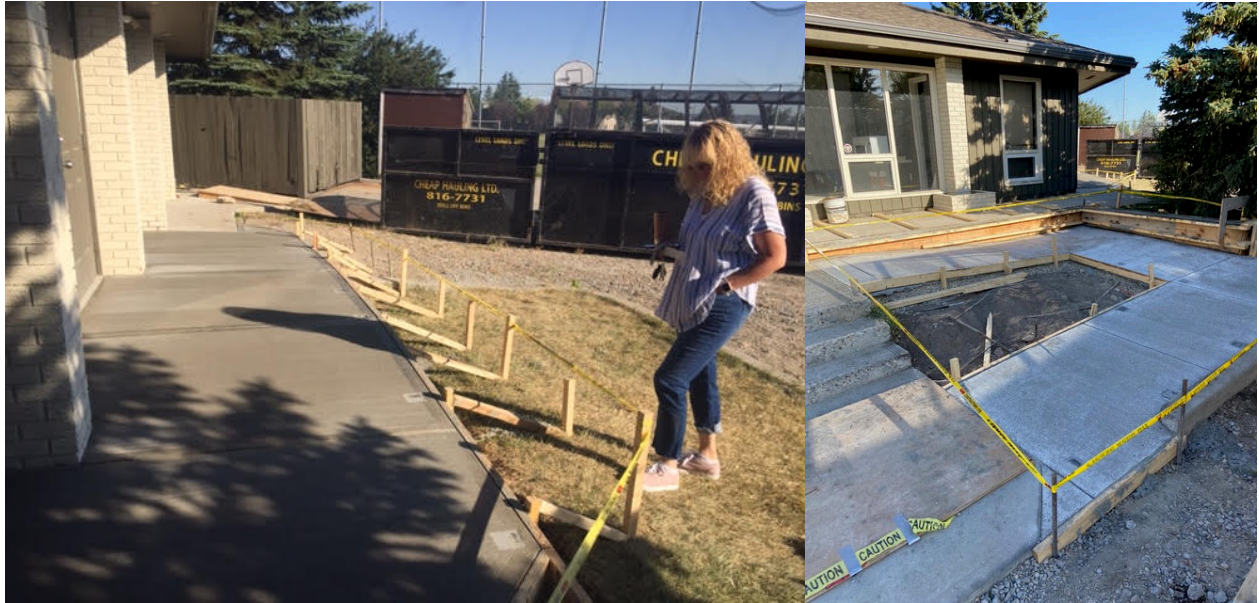
ANOTHER WEEK OF PROGRESS!

CEILINGS & CORRIDORS TAKE SHAPE

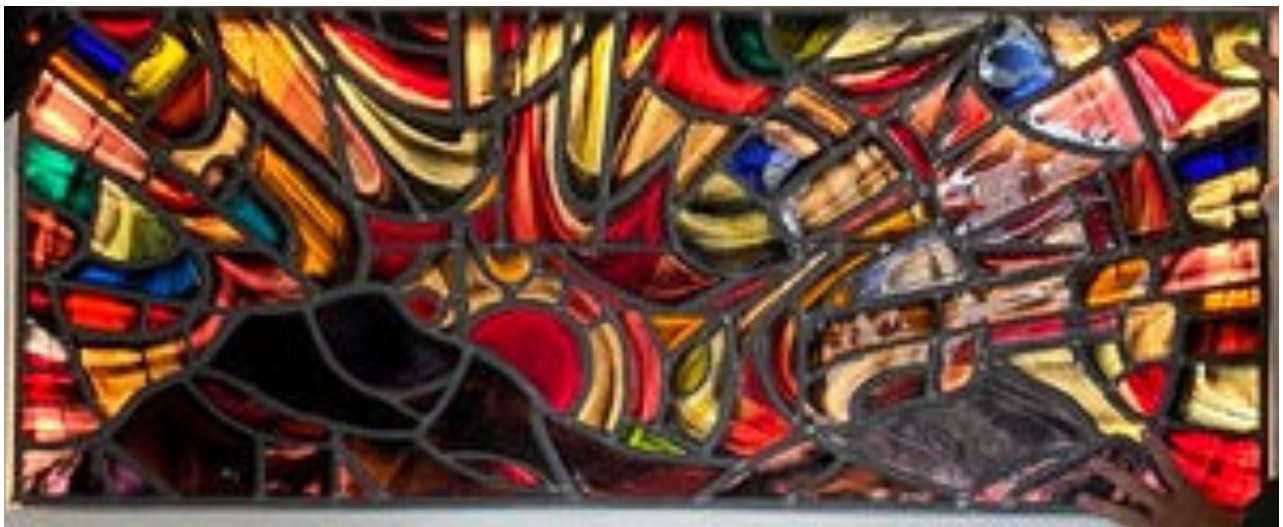


More Drywalling, More Insulation

The Exciting Mystery of The Triptych

Three rectangular stained glass windows have been in storage for twenty years in a wooden crate. We know very little about their history and could find no information about where they were in the old church or hall. There were no pictures to show what they looked like. In their storage crate we had only seen the top one which looked like a colourful abstract design. We always assumed the other two were also abstracts and now we hope to use them in our new church.

Last Friday the three windows were unpacked to see how they would work in the mock up light box built by the electrician. Amazingly the panels are actually a triptych of the foothills and mountains with a sunset. Here are two of them.



The work is signed R.Kilburn 1983. Preliminary research indicates the well-known Canadian artist Rosemary Kilbourn. Perhaps someone in the congregation can help provide more information on the work.
